The Drama department have organised a trip for students to watch a performance of 'School of Rock' on Wednesday 18th January 2017 at the New London Theatre, Drury Lane London, WC2B 5PW. Andrew Lloyd Webber, the man who brought rock and romance to Broadway, is back with a new heart-stirring hit. SCHOOL OF ROCK is a New York Times Critics' Pick and "AN INSPIRING JOLT OF ENERGY, JOY AND MAD SKILLZ!" Based on the iconic, hit movie, this irresistible new musical follows Dewey Finn, a failed, wannabe rock star who decides to earn an extra bit of cash by posing as a supply teacher at a prestigious prep school. There he turns a class of straight –A pupils into a guitar-shredding, bass-slapping mind-blowing rock band. But can he get them to the Battle of the Bands without their parents and the school's headmistress finding out?

The students will be travelling by coach accompanied by Mr Garbutt and will depart from school at 5.00pm and will return approximately 11.00pm. Due to the unsociable hours, the pick up point for this trip will be outside Chef Peking, Church Green. Students should wear smart/casual clothes.

The cost of the trip is £33.00 per student which, in accordance with the Governors' policy on charging, must be met by voluntary contributions. The school applies for financial assistance to a local charity which has very limited resources and therefore assistance can only be given if certain financial criteria can be fulfilled. Any such trip puts a great deal of added responsibility on staff and we therefore reserve the right to refuse to allow those pupils to participate whose behaviour gives grounds for concern

If paying by ParentPay, consent is given online and therefore the reply slip below is not required. Please note that all payments are non-refundable unless a replacement can be found in the school. **Places are limited on this trip and will be allocated to students on a first come first served basis.**
