## How to learn vocabulary & spellings

### Top tips

- write the words in a notebook (with their translations or definitions)
- write the words and definitions on small cards
- say the words many times
- type the word into a translate site (Leo online) to hear how the word is pronounced
- put the words into different groups (you could use a graphic organiser)
- use with a computer programme, such as Quizlet
- make associations (in pictures or with other words)
- ask someone to test you
- use the words in your own speaking or writing

DON'T LEAVE IT TO THE LAST MINUTE, learn a few words at a time and keep double checking
