TASK 3: Essay writing

Write a two sided (A4) essay on the Nature-Nurture debate for explaining human behaviour.

Your essay could be on any behaviour of your choosing but here are some suggestions.

Aggression Schizophrenia Anorexia Personality

You will need to research and present both sides of the debate and end in a conclusion weighing up the evidence that you have found.

Ideas for essay structure:

Describe what we mean by Nature. Describe what we mean by Nurture. Describe how Nature is thought to affect the behaviour. Describe how Nurture is thought to affect the behaviour. Use Research on both sides of the argument to support your descriptions. Conclude – which is the most convincing argument? Why Nature? Why Nurture? Or is it a mixture of both?
