Careers under the Spotlight: J Hazell

Y10 Student's Work Shadowing Day at Red Bull Racing MK7, Milton Keynes

Red Bull Mark

Where did you go for your work shadowing day?

I went to the Red Bull Racing MK7 facilities, in Milton Keynes. This consisted of Red Bull powertrains, advanced technology, a facility that held esports and a museum of famous stunts that Red Bull have done.

What type of activities did you observe or get involved in?

I was lucky to have the privilege to see a variety of things, such as designs for the car, building parts for the car, moulds for different parts and even took part in creating an oil rig.

What did you enjoy about the day?

The whole day was very surreal, F1 is a sport that I like so much. From being behind the scenes and seeing all the details involved in F1, I was able to get further insight and knowledge about the sport and how to succeed. For example, just one of six spark plugs cost £60,000, with many other machines and parts costing millions of pounds, this shows how expensive the parts and materials are, as well as how much effort goes into this sport.

Was there anything that surprised you?

I was surprised by how big the facility was! It consists of three large buildings, with a fourth currently being built. The scale and the expense at the Red Bull F1 Racing facility really blew me away, it made me realise how much effort goes into Formula 1.

How has the day influenced your thoughts on the future?

The day has opened up an apprenticeship opportunity and has given me a clear aim to work towards something in my future.

Before this experience I didn't know what I was going to do but this has given me lots of ideas, as well as motivated me to up my grades and try even harder at school!

Robotics Engineer

Day To Day Skills

- Research what customers want to automate.
- Make design using computer aided design (CAD) software.
- Build and test prototypes and fix faults.
- Analyse data from robot sensors and cameras.
- Report on risks, issues and project progress.
- Research new ways to use robots and artificial intelligence.

Robotics Engineers design and build machines to do automated jobs in industries like manufacturing, aerospace and medicine.

Routes into the industry

Apply for an college course which might help you to find a job as a robotics technician. Courses include:

- Level 3 Certificate in Robotics and Automation.
- · Level 4 Diploma in Computing.
- Higher National Certificate in Electrical or Electronic Engineering.

With further training, you could then qualify as a robotics engineer.

4 or 5 GCSEs at grade 9 to 4 (A* to C), or equivalent, for a level 3 college course.

Salary

From £27,500 for a starter, rising to £55,500 for an experienced Robotics Engineer.

Jobs

There will be 3.3% more Robotics Engineer jobs in 2027.

In 2020 the average salary was £31,461, up 3.6% on 2019.

Annual pay estimates are largely unaffected by Covid-19.

In keeping with our commitment to provide students with outstanding careers guidance and tailored support when choosing their next steps after Roundwood Park school, we will now be using Unifrog; an award-winning, online destinations platform. All students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 now have access to this website.

Unifrog is the universal destinations platform and is designed to support learners in making the most informed decisions about their futures and has a range of tools that are suitable for all year groups. Each student has their own account where they can explore all the career and next step options available to them and find information on everything from managing their workload to writing a winning CV. Students have access to a wide variety of video and written content, and interactive quizzes and tests, including:

Quizzes	Finding their interests, personality type, preferred work environment, and skillset.	Years 7-13
Exploring pathways	Explore careers, career sectors, subjects, sign up to free webinars, explore MOOCs and courses, and find wider reading materials.	Years 7-13

Students access the platform by clicking on the Unifrog tile on RMUnify. They sign in to Unifrog using their school email address and password and they can do so from any computer, tablet, or smartphone. We would encourage you to use the platform with your child so you can support them through the process of deciding their next steps.

You can also have your own Unifrog account. You'll be able to research careers, attend webinars delivered by employers and universities to learn more about their opportunities, and compare pathways so you can support your child in making an informed decision about their next steps.
