













Spanish Study trip to Madrid, Spain

Friday 2nd – Monday 5th February 2024

The Modern Foreign Languages department is planning a language intense trip to Madrid which is open for all Y10 students studying Spanish. The 4-day, 3-night trip to this large, lively city will take us on a tour, rich in Spanish culture and modern adventures, sure to inspire any Spanish language enthusiast. During our stay, we will explore many parks, monuments and attractions combining an insight into Spanish history with fun elements such as a guided tour of 'Las Ventas' Bullring, a visit to 'El Museo de Iluisones' as well as a Flamenco Show.

Our accommodation in the heart of Madrid will be on a half-board basis with evening meals being planned in a selection of local restaurants across the city. All flights, transport in Spain, entrance fees and insurance are included. We will be departing from RPS on Friday morning and returning on Monday evening (times TBC). Coach transfers to/from the airport are included.

Students must have a valid passport that is less than 10 years old from date of issue, with a minimum of 3 months validity remaining after the trip. All students will also need a valid GHIC card which can be obtained free of charge from https://www.nhs.uk/using-thenhs/healthcare-abroad/apply-for-a-free-uk-global-health-insurance-card-ghic/. A copy of your son/daughter's passport and GHIC card will be requested at a later date, but if you need to renew, please do so straight away.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £820-£880 dependant on numbers and final itinerary. This is subject to fluctuations in flight costs and the final excursion programme. In accordance with the Governors' policy on charging, this cost must be met through voluntary contributions from parents/carers.

We do not want cost to be a barrier. We work closely with the James Marshall Foundation who can provide funding for students with a low family income, living in Harpenden, Wheathampstead, Kimpton, Redbourn, Flamstead and Markyate. To secure your son/daughter's place on this trip we require you to submit your acceptance below and pay a non-refundable deposit of £250* via ParentPay no later than Friday 6th October 2023. Please note that whilst we will do our best to accommodate all students keen to travel, we will need to apply a first come, first served priority if this trip is oversubscribed. Priority will be given in order of permissions received via Operoo.

*Please note that if your son/daughter secures a place but then decides to withdraw from the trip, you must notify us immediately in writing as you will be liable for any cancellation costs incurred if a replacement cannot be found. The school reserves the right to withdraw from the trip any student whose behavioural record at school proves inconsistent with the safe running of the trip.

If we do not get the required student numbers to make this trip viable, any payments made will be refunded in full

The remaining balance will be due in a further two instalments

Interim Instalment 1: £300 by Monday 6th November 2023

Final Balance: approx. £330 (TBC) by Friday 8th December 2023
