Dear Parents and Carers

You will have heard in the press over the last two days about Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC), a form of concrete used widely in the building of schools and other spaces for many decades.

We do not have any confirmed RAAC in our buildings and have not been asked to close any areas. However, we do want to take care and to be sure. Therefore, the DfE will be coming on site to conduct a survey to see if RAAC has been used in the construction of any part of our buildings. They will do this some time in the next few weeks. To put this into context, they will be doing this in at least 100 schools in Hertfordshire. If any RAAC is identified, we will let you know straight away, take immediate action to make sure we are all safe and we will have contingencies in place.
