KEY STAGES 3 & 4 NETBALL TOUR TO SWINDON Friday 10th – Sun 12th May 2024

As a reward for the success and dedication of our Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4 netball players, the PE department has arranged a netball weekend away. It is a tightly run event organised by PGL which aims to allow the girls to take part in as many matches as possible in the time available. Girls will benefit from the experience of a residential course which itself helps build a strong team identity. The PGL staff-led adventure sessions focus on identifying opportunities for both team- and confidence-building. These may include climbing, high ropes, trapeze, fencing, zip wire and abseiling.

The **cost of the trip is estimated to be £209 per student** which includes full board accommodation, travel from school, all activities and insurance (please note that personal items such as mobile phones, ipods and cameras are not covered on the school's insurance policy). These costs, in accordance with the Governors' policy on charging for trips, must be met by voluntary contributions.

If your daughter would like a place on this trip, please accept this trip in your Operoo response, giving your permission. **The deadline for responses is Wednesday 15th November**. Due to the popularity of this trip we are capping places at 20 students per year group (8/9/10)

If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated by year group based on the time/date stamp on your Operoo response. Once all spaces have been filled, additional students will be placed on a waiting list. On Monday 20th November, we will collate the responses and you will receive a message to confirm if your daughter has been allocated a space. Parentpay will then be opened up to enable you to pay a non-refundable deposit of £100, which must be paid no later than Thursday 30th November. If we have not received your deposit by this date, we will assume that your daughter is no longer interested.

The final instalment, which is currently estimated to be £109, will be due by Monday 4th March 2024.



We do not want cost to be a barrier. We work closely with James Marshall foundation who can provide funding for students with a low family income, living in Harpenden, Wheathampstead, Kimpton, Redbourn, Flamstead and Markyate.
