Y9 Science trip to Euro Space Centre, Belgium Sunday 23rd – Weds 26th June 2024

A trip has been organised for Year 9 students during our summer enrichment week to develop their science capital and take part in exciting space focused activities designed to fit the specific age of our students.

The Euro Space Centre in Belgium is a unique European educational centre dedicated to space travel and learning about galaxies and the planets of our solar system. This fascinating complex offers training courses, workshops and numerous exhibitions, where participants can experience an array of interactive and visual displays, with a huge emphasis on 'Making Science Fun'.

With the equivalent of two and a half days at the Centre, students will engage in interactive activities which simulate space travel, such as the zero-gravity wall, the multi-axis chair and the moon walk; learn about the challenges astronauts face in performing simple everyday activities in space; gain a deeper understanding of astronomy, the history of space conquest and the role of the International Space Station; engage with their team in the simulated launch and landing of a US Space Shuttle; and have the opportunity to design, build and launch a rocket.



The students will be travelling by coach from school early Sunday morning, arriving in Belgium Sunday afternoon, and will depart from the centre Wednesday morning, returning to Roundwood Park on Wednesday evening. The centre offers full board, including three meals a day. Insurance is also included.

The unique centre consists of a connected accommodation building with multi-bedded dormitory rooms, Each room has private showers and allocated WC facilities. The site also boasts 2 restaurants (where all meals are taken), a souvenir shop, cinema, numerous classrooms and ample outside space for evening activities. Students will also enjoy a torchlight tour around the impressive nearby Bouillon Caste, a Cave visit and a stop at a Belgian chocolate factory and shop on the way home..

The cost of the trip will be approximately £715-£725 per student, depending on final numbers. In accordance with the Governors' policy on charging, must be met by voluntary contributions. We do not want cost to be a barrier. We work closely with James Marshall foundation who can provide funding for students with a low family income, living in Harpenden, Wheathampstead, Kimpton, Redbourn, Flamstead and Markyate. You will also need to pay a non-refundable deposit of £175 via ParentPay no later than 30th November. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis based on the time/date of your Operoo response. If this trip is oversubscribed, students who are unsuccessful in securing a space, will be placed on a waiting list and deposits will be returned.

- Instalment £175 due by Monday 12th February 24
- Final payment £190(TBC) due by Friday 15th March 24
