



## Yr 12 Geography Field Studies Trip to Liverpool Mon 8<sup>th</sup> July – Fri 12<sup>th</sup> July 2024

26th January 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

As an essential part of the A Level geography course, all students need to complete a geographical fieldwork investigation in either a coastal or urban environment. The Geography Department has arranged for fieldwork to be carried out in Liverpool city centre to investigate urban regeneration, as well as to study sand dunes and coastal habitats and processes in nearby Formby. Having first been shown the range of topics for study in each location, the students will then be supported in formulating their own geographical enquiry with an individually planned question/hypothesis and methodology. Assisted by geography staff, students will then have two full days to collect primary data to fulfil the aims of their investigation in either Liverpool's city centre or along Formby's coastline. This primary research will be used to write an individual coursework project (NEA) which accounts for 20% of their overall A level grade.

We estimate that the **cost of this trip will be around £465-£500 per student,** depending on interest and includes research support by qualified Geographers, all transport, full board accommodation, evening activities. Scheduled entertainment activities will include an escape room, bowling, meal out, and a Liverpool Football Club Stadium tour. All costs, in accordance with the Governors' policy on charging for trips, must be met by voluntary contributions.

The trip cost includes insurance. Please note that personal items such as mobile phones, iPods and cameras are not covered on the school's insurance policy.

To secure a place for your son/daughter, please reply to this eForm and make your non- refundable deposit payment of £100 on Parent Pay by Monday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2024.

The remaining payments will be due as follows: £120 by 28<sup>th</sup> March 2024 £120 by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024 £125 approx (TBC) by 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2024.





We do not want cost to be a barrier. If you live in Harpenden, Wheathampstead, Redbourn, Flamstead or Markyate, you can apply online for funding via the James Marshall Foundation by clicking <a href="here">here</a>.

If you live outside of these areas, please contact me in the first instance <u>no later than</u> Monday 12<sup>th</sup> February, to discuss funding options or an individual payment plan.
