Assessments will take place **w/c Monday 20th May** and **w/c Monday 3rd June**. Paper one will be a non-calculator paper and paper 2 will be a calculator paper.

In terms of equipment, students are expected to have a pen, pencil, ruler, protractor, pair of compasses and a scientific calculator (for paper 2).

- To complete all home learning tasks
- To use previous learning, testing, SPARX and other means to revise and practise
