Dear Parents and Carers,

NON-UNIFORM DAYS – Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12

Firstly, for the benefit of parents who are new to the school, Roundwood Park has previously run **6** non-uniform days with donations of £2 each throughout the year. All funds raised are divided equally between our designated school charities, (see below), which were voted for by the students.

The three charities being supported this year:

- Our local charity is *St Albans and District Food Bank*, which provides emergency food and support to local people in crisis.
- Our national charity is *Make-A-Wish*, which brings light and joy to children and their loved ones following a childhood diagnosis of a critical illness. It leaves a profound and lasting impact on all their lives.
- Our international charity is *Mercy Ships* a global Christian charity that hope to bring healing to those suffering from disability, disfigurement, and disease. They deploy hospital ships and partner with African nations to transform surgical systems and provide free surgery to those most in need.

Parents may pay for non-uniform via ParentPay in one of two ways. A one-off yearly payment of £12 payable by **Monday 21st October** or there will also be the option to pay for each non-uniform day individually (£2 per time).

We would ask that payments are made online where possible however, students may bring cash in a named envelope if they prefer and this should be handed in at the Finance office.

The schedule of non-uniform days for the **2024/25** academic year is as follows:
