**THE SMALLPRINT:**

- Payment by ParentPay - you **MUST** confirm your menu **option 1-6** & **state any allergies** using the notes section
- No other food or drinks will be available on 17 December - 6th Formers and those not having a Christmas option will need to bring a packed lunch
- All students should bring a **bottle of water** as no other drinks will be available
- Lunch will run as normal on 18 December for Yrs7-11 & 6th Formers who opt out





# FURTHER INFORMATION




- Unfortunately, if you miss the order deadline of 19 November, your son/daughter will require a packed lunch on 17 December as there will be no other food available.
- Those having packed lunches will be able to eat their lunch in the canteen with their year group and friends so they won't miss out on the fun!
- The Christmas meal is ordered in quantities to meet demand and therefore regretfully, we will be unable to provide a refund if your son/daughter is absent on the day.
- **Free school meal** students will automatically be allocated a meal. Parents/carers will receive a link separately to let us know of your menu choice and any specific requirements.

## Allergies

When choosing your meal option and paying the £4.00 required on ParentPay you **MUST STATE** if your child has an allergy in the notes section. It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that the information provided is correct

Please be aware that while all precautions and processes are in place within our kitchens to accommodate dietary conditions, there is always a risk that traces of allergens may be transferred to food from our providers, which is beyond our control. For this reason Roundwood Park School is unable to guarantee that any food on any of our menus is completely free from trace allergens. It is also the students' responsibility to inform staff, when being served, of any food allergy or intolerance.
