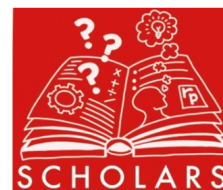


Key Stage 5 Spanish



Task	Details	Points
Create your own dictionary.	Always carry a small notebook divided alphabetically, and start writing down all the new words you learn. Include their meanings and also their grammatical category - whether they are verbs, nouns, adjectives, or adverbs	5pts
Set your phone's language to Spanish.	Change the language on your phone to Spanish for a week and jot down all the vocabulary you learn	5pts
Challenge verb	Learn 5 new verbs every week and write them down in the present, preterite, imperfect, past perfect, and conditional tenses.	5pts
