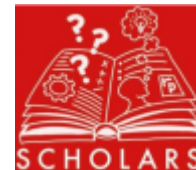




GCSE Art



Task	Details	Points
Read	Look at this website to see what people say about their careers in the arts. Choose a few which appeal to you and say what you like about them. https://creativejourneyuk.com/	5pts
Read	Choose an art style or artist and read about it. Go to the library and talk to the librarian about what you are looking for.	5pts
Research	Find out about art from a different culture or country. This could be based on any art, craft or design form. Relay your findings to your teacher.	5pts
Read	Read articles in old or current art magazines. Eg: RA magazine, Tate magazine, Artists and Illustrators, Crafts magazine. There are lots of back issues in the art department. Create a collage of the article and the key findings in your sketchbook.	10pts
Create	Create a painting using only food to make colour or a photographic outcome.	10pts
Create	Create a piece of art work entirely out of recycled objects	10pts
Research	Research and make your own paints, pigments or dyes. Create your own egg tempera or other paints. Create your own book of samples.	15pts
Create	Research a style of art that you are interested in and inspired by, find an artist who creates that work and create a double page spread in the back of your sketchbook about them.	15pts
Read	Read a book from the suggested reading list for GCSE and write a 200 word summary of your findings.	
Oracy challenge	<p>The ARTiculation Challenge:</p> <p>Research the ARTiculation Prize (a public speaking competition about art). Watch past entrants' speeches on YouTube. Select an artwork you love and prepare a full, 10-minute presentation on it. Practice presenting this to an audience (classmates, friends, family) to hone your public speaking and critical analysis skills.</p>	15pts



Visit	Create a sketchbook called your 'art exhibitions book'. Goto a museum or gallery that is listed here and draw the work or objects you see and make at least one double page of research.	20pts
Read	Read about the work of Sam Taylor-Johnson (particularly her <i>A Little Death</i> series). She films food decaying over time. This directly links all three themes—Natural Form, Edible, and Decay— then respond by making your own short film.	20pts
Experiment	Create / buy a concertina sketchbook and fill it with experimentations using different materials, paints and techniques. Linking to either the theme: natural form or growth and decay.	20 pts
Challenge	Enter a competition with a piece of your own original art work.	20 pts
