Task	Details	Points
Read or listen to an article	Keep up to date with current affairs in Spain. Read an article or listen to a podcast about what is currently happening in the Spanish-speaking world and create a poster in English to explain what it was about https://spanishinlevels.com/ https://www.newsinslowspanish.com/	5pts
Speaking	Choose or draw 5 images that represent your life (hobbies, family, school, daily routine, dreams). For each image, prepare and record a short paragraph (4–6 sentences) in Spanish. Try to include: ○ Present tense verbs (e.g. <i>juego, estudio</i>) ○ Opinions (e.g. <i>me gusta, odio, prefiero...</i>) ○ Time phrases (e.g. <i>normalmente, los fines de semana</i>)	5pts
Listen to music from the Spanish-speaking world	Choose two popular Spanish-language songs (from artists like Shakira, Aitana, Bad Bunny, Camilo, etc.). Look up the lyrics and listen carefully to each song at least twice. Choose 10 new vocabulary items from each song and write: ○ The Spanish word/phrase ○ Its meaning in English ○ A sentence using the word in your own context (in Spanish) OR Write a short review (in Spanish or English) comparing the two songs. Include: ○ Which one you liked more and why	5pts

	○ How they are different/similar (style, mood, lyrics)	
Spanish idioms	Research 10 common Spanish idioms or expressions (e.g. "Es pan comido") ● Write their literal meanings ● Provide the English equivalent ● Create short example sentences (in Spanish) for at least 3 of them	
Read and summarise	Look through some of the excellent language magazines that we subscribe to at school. They are in ML6 or in the library, and also available via this website (the Spanish ones are on the left when you click this link). Write an 80-100 word summary in English about what you have read.	10pts
Learn and perform	Learn a regional dance from Spain or South America. There are many to choose from - film yourself doing the dance with the music! https://www.youtube.com/results?search_query=hispanic+regional+dances	10pts
Plan Your Dream Trip to a Spanish-speaking Country	Use the future tense and travel-related vocabulary to plan an imaginary holiday. <u>Choose one:</u> ● Design a travel brochure or poster ● Create a PowerPoint/Canva presentation ● Record a video itinerary describing your plans	10pts
Watch & Analyse a Spanish-Language Film or Series Episode	Choose a Spanish-language film or series episode with English or Spanish subtitles. Some suggestions: ● <i>Coco</i> (Pixar, set in Mexico) ● <i>Zipi y Zape y el club de la canica</i> (comedy/adventure) ● <i>El Internado</i> (TV mystery/drama) ● <i>Encanto</i> (Colombia, great for vocab and music) Write a film review in Spanish (around 150–200 words) https://quizlet.com/251911150/cinema-movie-vocabulary-spanish-english-flash-cards/	10pts

Interview	Find someone who speaks Spanish and create an interview with them. Find out about their free time, family and what they like doing and why. What subject did they like best in school? Was it Spanish? Either do a write-up from the interview or record the interview taking place.	10pts
Create Your Own Spanish Magazine	Create a mini digital or paper magazine (6–8 pages) with a mix of text types (articles, interviews, reviews, etc.) that reflect your interests, school life, and Spanish-speaking culture.	15pts
Launch Your Own pretend Spanish YouTube Channel	Imagine you're launching a Spanish-language YouTube channel for learners or teenagers. You'll create a 5–7 minute video (or storyboard) and supporting materials in Spanish. Channel Concept + Logo: Choose your theme: travel, fashion, sport, food, student life, gaming, etc. Design a name and simple logo. Write a short channel description in Spanish (e.g., <i>¡Bienvenidos a mi canal! Aquí hablo sobre...</i>) Video Planning and Recording: Create a script and record at least 5 videos in Spanish (approx. 400–500 words each).	15pts
Practise	Complete a 100-day streak on Duo-lingo for Spanish and write down at least 30 words you have learnt in both Spanish and English. Document your experience in 500 words, considering the impact it has had on your in-class learning, what Aspire skills you have used (e.g. resilience) and whether you would recommend others use DuoLingo to boost their learning.	20pts
Create a Digital Spanish Autobiography & Cultural Portfolio	Create a rich, creative digital autobiography and cultural portfolio in Spanish that showcases your language skills, personal identity, and understanding of the Spanish-speaking world. You can use animation tools like Canva Video, Powtoon or apps like iMovie/Capcut..
