



Key Stage 5 Spanish



Task	Details	Points
Create your own dictionary.	Always carry a small notebook divided alphabetically, and start writing down all the new words you learn. Include their meanings and also their grammatical category - whether they are verbs, nouns, adjectives, or adverbs. You need to have at least 150 words.	5pts
Set your phone's language to Spanish	Change the language on your phone to Spanish for a week and jot down all the vocabulary you learn	5pts
Verb challenge	Learn 5 new verbs every week and write them down in the present, preterite, imperfect, past perfect, and conditional tenses.	5pts
Grammar revision	Choose a grammar point or tense you or others often find confusing; create a revision guide/tool or video that clearly explains it.	5pts
Daily news	Watch the daily news online. Choose one article in Spanish and find the equivalent/similar article in English. See how many of the same words/ideas come up in both articles and write them down. https://www.telecinco.es/informativos/ https://elpais.com/ https://www.bbc.com/mundo vs https://www.bbc.co.uk/news	10pts
Cooking	Read a recipe for a Spanish or South American dish and make it; either bring it in for us to try in class, take pictures of the process to show us or create a video to show us the process. Find ideas here: https://comedera.com/100-platos-comida-espanola/	10pts
Museo del Prado/La Sagrada	Take an interactive tour of the artwork at Museo del Prado or La Sagrada Familia and then write around 300 words in Spanish, including the most important facts, why	10pts

Spanish film	Watch a Spanish film and write a film review in Spanish of around 150-200 words - make sure to analyse not just describe. <u>Choosing one of the films you are not studying would be a good idea.</u> <u>Include:</u> - What the film was about - Analyse the key characters/themes - What you liked most/least - If you would recommend to someone else	10pts
Research a significant historical event	Research a significant historical or political event in Spain or a Spanish speaking country and create a poster for display to educate our younger students. This should ideally be in both Spanish and English	15pts
Branching out	Take part in a Spanish event or competition e.g. https://londres.cervantes.es/en/culture_spanish/activities_cultural_spanish.shtm https://www.all-languages.org.uk/news-events/challenges-and-competitions/	15pts
Volunteer your Spanish skills	Volunteer one of your free periods each week to help KS3 or KS4 students with their Spanish speaking. Do this for at least 6 weeks.	15pts
Read a novel	Read a book in Spanish, potentially <u>one of the ones you are not studying</u> and write a 500 word review in Spanish.	20pts
