Task	Details	Points
My Spanish-Speaking Hero poster	Choose a famous person from a Spanish-speaking country and create a short poster or presentation in Spanish. You could include physical description, what their family is like, what activities they like to do and any other relevant information about them using vocab we have looked at in class.	5pts
Flashcard Vocabulary Challenge	Create a set of flashcards with at least ten Spanish words on one side and either pictures or the English on the other. You could even do sentences to revise a specific grammar point such as the present tense or adjectives	5pts
Take a virtual tour	Choose an online museum or area of Spain and take an online virtual tour and write down 5 things you have learnt from taking the tour	5pts
Watch a programme in Spanish	Watch an episode of Peppa Pig in Spanish and write down 20 new vocab words that you learnt from that episode https://www.youtube.com/@PeppaPigEspanolOficial	5pts

Listen to a Podcast	Such as ' <i>seis minutos</i> ', ' <i>Coffee Break Spanish</i> ', ' <i>Duolingo Spanish Podcast</i> ' or ' <i>Notes in Spanish</i> ' and write a 100 word summary in English of what it was about	5pts
Create a weather report for Spain	Write and present a weather report for different regions of Spain e.g 'En Madrid normalmente hace sol' You can either record a video, voice recording or in written form with visuals such as a map	10pts
Watch a film in Spanish	Choose a Spanish film or series and write a 100-200 word summary in English about what it was about, what your favourite part was, describe the characters and list 10 new vocab words you learnt from watching it. E.g Coco, Dora the Explorer, Pachamama, Zipe and Zape, Olé	10pts
Research a recipe in Spanish and make it	Find a typical Hispanic dish and make it using the Spanish recipe. Write a review of your experience; include the recipe and any photos of the process/outcome or video yourself completing the whole process.	10pts
Be creative	Create a Spanish landmark out of paper or other resources, if you can make it in 3D even better. Some ideas of Spanish landmarks are here	10pts
Create a Spanish food diary	Keep a diary of all the meals you have for a week and create a diary/storyboard about it, include pictures/drawings and use Spanish food vocabulary. Don't forget to include the verbs 'como' and 'bebo'. If you really want to push yourself, you can use them in the past tense too!	15 pts

Design a Travel Guide for a Spanish-Speaking Destination	Choose a Spanish-speaking city or region and design a travel guide/pamphlet for British tourists. This could include key landmarks, activities, recommendations for cultural activities and practical tips for travellers	15pts
Build a "Spanish Culture in Focus" Mini-Project	Research and present a cultural topic related to the Spanish-speaking world such as a festival like <i>Las Fallas</i>, a city like <i>Madrid</i> or a tradition like <i>Tapas</i>. Then create a mini-report, leaflet, or slide show in English with some Spanish phrases included. <u>What to include:</u> • Facts and history of the topic • Photos or illustrations • A glossary of 5 useful Spanish words with English translation	15pts
Create a boardgame	Choose an element of Spanish grammar or vocab you have learnt so far and create a game of your choice which others could use to test/revise that particular grammar point. This must not be an online game. E.g Monopoly or a card game	20pts
"Mi Serie en Español" – Create Your Own Mini Spanish TV Series	Create a short original TV episode (5–8 mins) in Spanish, suitable for teenagers, either individually or in a small group. The series must be set in a Spanish-speaking country.	20pts
