Task	Details	Points
Read an Article	Choose 1 of your other A level subjects and find a relevant article about it in French. Summarise the article in French.	5pts
Ted Talks	Find and watch 2 Ted Talks in French and write a summary of them in French.	5pts
MLAT	Complete 2 MLAT papers from here Submit your completed answers alongside a self-corrected/marked copy using the official mark schemes.	5pts
'Frenchship' Whatsapp group	Create a Whatsapp group for your French class. Send at least 3 messages in French each week. Submit a monthly export or scrolling screenshot document showing your contributions	5pts
Grammar Revision resource	Pick a grammar point that often causes confusion. Make a 1-page revision guide, short video, or infographic (in French or bilingual) that explains the concept clearly.	5pts
Art work exploration	Choose a painting, sculpture, or photograph by a French or Francophone artist (e.g., Monet, Delacroix, Niki de Saint Phalle, Seydou Keïta). Write a short description in French (approx. 100–150 words) including what you see, the emotions it evokes, and why you chose it.	10pts
Francophonie research	Research a French-speaking country outside of Europe and write a short article about its history, culture and customs.	10pts
French History	Read about a period of French history of your choosing and create a fact file/summary in French	10pts
Current Affairs	Choose a major news event or theme (e.g., French elections, climate policy, strikes, cultural debates) and track how it develops over 3–4 weeks. Create a weekly summary in French and reflect on how the coverage or public reaction changes over time.	10pts
French dept event	Collaborate with another student to plan an enrichment event for KS3 French. This could be something like a spelling bee, song competition, or a pétanque tournament. Submit your written event proposal plan, resources used, and a teacher sign-off confirmation once the event is executed	15pts
Watch a French film & write a review	Choose one of the films from the AQA 'Works' that you are not already studying & write a review in French	15pts
National Competition	Take part in one of the national French competitions that are held each year for A level students studying French e.g. The Anthea Bell Translation Competition . Submit a copy of your final entry submission alongside your official entry confirmation email.	15 pts

Penpal	Find a French speaking penpal and write regular letters or emails over at least 6 months. Submit a portfolio containing anonymized copies or screenshots of at least 6 sent emails/letters across the timeline.	15pts
Vlog	Over half a term, record yourself once a week talking about your week, opinions, or topics of interest – all in French (1–2 minutes). Share these with your teacher.	15pts
Read a French novel & write a review	Choose three of the books from the AQA 'Works' that you are not already studying & write a review for each one in French	20pts
Mentor	Mentor a French student from a younger year group. Maintain a mentor log listing dates, session topics, and obtain a signature from the mentee's class teacher at the end of each month	20pts
French conversation café	Start a fortnightly informal French-speaking lunch group. Choose a theme to discuss each week in French and keep a short journal in French summarising what you talked about each session and vocabulary you picked up.	20pts
